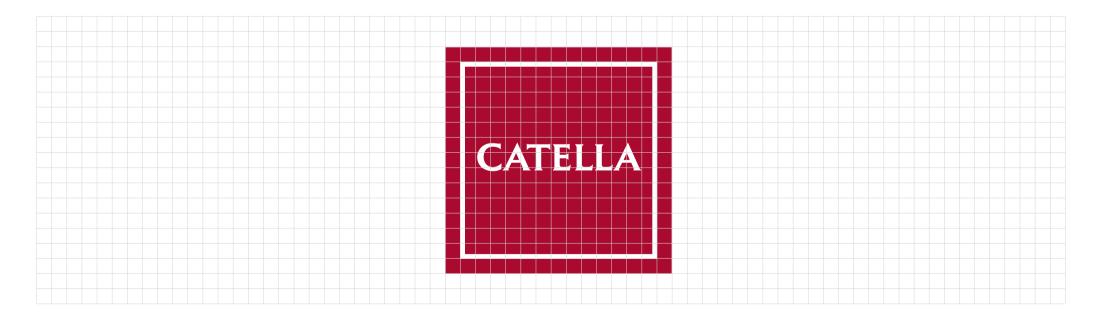

THE CATELLA LOGOTYPE

he Catella logo comprises a red framed square with the wordmark Catella inside. Always use all the elements together as shown, do not rearrange or alter the logo in any way. The logo uses hand-drawn letters which can never be replaced by a regular font.





CLEAR SPACE

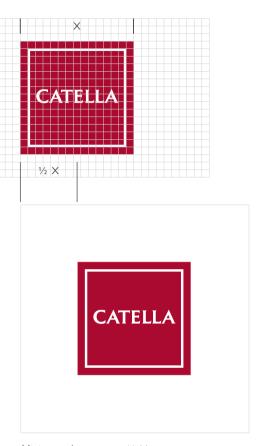
lways maintain the clear space around the Catella logo. No graphic element or text should be allowed to interfere with the clear space. The logo must not be placed closer to an edge than 7 mm or, if ½ X exceeds 7 mm, whatever the clear space requirements stipulate. The minimum amount of clear space required around the logo is equal to ½ X (X=total length of the Catella logotype).

MINIMUM SIZE

nsure that the logo meets the minimum size requirements that are crucial for brand visibility. Shrinking it too much compromises legibility, detail, and impact, making it ineffective in various applications. The logo represents our brand's identity and should command attention. Respect the minimum size guidelines to maintain a strong visual presence and convey a professional image.



The minimum width for the Catella logo is 10 mm wide. Be sure to always maintain proper proportions when scaling the logo.



Minimum clear space = $\frac{1}{2}$ X

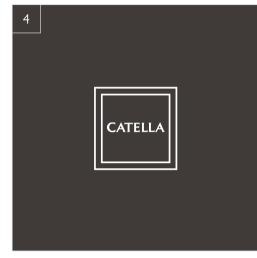
1. Catella Primary Logotype. Our main objective that the Catella color logo should be used at all times.
